

Euoniticellus africanus (male)

Dark patches on the pronotum are characteristic of both *E. africanus* and *E. pallipes*

V-shaped ridge is the distinguishing feature for male *E. africanus*

Characteristic dark spots on the pronotum. For *E. africanus* the pair of patches in the middle are usually larger and more distinct than those at the rear

E. africnaus is easily confused with *E. pallipes*. Examination of the ridges on the head is the most reliable way to tell them apart 1 mm
